

KS4 : Spanish Scheme of Work 2013 onwards

This Scheme of Work is designed to deliver the Edexcel (2009 onwards) Specification in Spanish over a period of two years.

The main resource is Edexcel GCSE Spanish (Pearsons) although other materials will be used to supplement this. As groups are likely to be wide-ranging in ability it is important to differentiate appropriately and there are Higher and Foundation versions of the book.

The minimum requirements for Controlled Assessment are

- 2 speaking tasks (set and marked by the centre, moderated by Edexcel)
 - 2 different tasks need to be done from the following:
 - presentation followed by a discussion
 - discussion based around a picture prompt
 - an open interaction (extended rôle-play)
- 2 pieces of written coursework (set by the centre, marked by Edexcel). At least 200 words should be written for those wishing to aim for a C or above. Each written piece needs to be completed within one hour (only a dictionary may be referred to).

The Scheme of Work allows for 3 speaking tasks and 3 written tasks to be done. Hence, candidates will have the opportunity to submit their best two pieces in each skill. It is important that teachers conduct assessments in accordance with Edexcel regulations, label and store work appropriately and securely. [A catch-up session might be possible in the Summer Term of Y11].

Preparation for the Controlled Assessment tasks (both speaking and writing) can take a maximum of 6 hours class-time study over a maximum of two weeks prior to the task being sat.

Edexcel will suggest tasks but we are able to devise our own similar ones if we wish.

The final examination will examine listening and reading skills.
