



Minutes from the School Council Meeting

Updates:

- After fees were removed, the Christmas fête raised approximately £300 to split between the school and Save the Children.
- Last meeting contained a small council however progress was still made. The councillors discussed what is good about the school and improvements that can be made.
- Meetings of the Council Leading Committee with Mr. Clayton, Mr. Swift and Mr. Smith are to be held to resolve gum issues, ventilation around school (T- block mainly) and changes to house matches.

Issues Resolved

- The council agreed that to sort out issues with gum around the school, gum duty should be re-enforced and people caught chewing gum should be put in detention as referrals alone are said to not be proving effective. We also agreed that all students in after school detention should be on gum duty as then this will clean up the gum and at the same time should deter bad behaviour and students from chewing gum as a worse punishment will be the outcome.

- It was agreed that to improve the school, various equipment should be replaced such as old glues in most lessons and the bibs in P.E.
